



- Jurisdiction to hear all matters involving:
 - Juvenile (children under 18) offenses (delinquency)
 - Specific family matters such as paternity actions, child abuse or neglect, custody and child support et al.

What Happens When a Minor Commits an Offense?




• **Delinquent** - The finding made in a juvenile case that a child has violated a law or ordinance. The term is used instead of "guilty," which applies to proceedings involving adults.


Specific Definition by the ORC.



• 2152.02 Delinquent children - juvenile traffic offender definitions - (E) "Delinquent child"










Considerations on How to Proceed




- Age of the juvenile
