<i>Definition of “Qualified Speaker”</i>			
Someone who is familiar with the recorded materials, who is present to expand upon and provide supplemental commentary and to answer questions posed by attendees. A qualified speaker also must have reviewed the recorded materials in their entirety prior to the replay and must remain in the same room with the attendees the entire time.
