This cause is pending before the Court on the certification of a state law question from the United States District Court, Southern District of Ohio, Western Division. Upon review of the preliminary memoranda pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. XVIII(6),

It is determined that the Court will answer the following question:

“Whether the next of kin of a decedent, upon whom an autopsy has been performed, have a protected right under Ohio law in the decedent’s tissues, organs, blood or other body parts that have been removed and retained by the coroner for forensic examination and testing.”

It is ordered by the Court that the petitioners shall file their merit brief within 40 days of the date of this corrected entry and the parties shall otherwise proceed in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. VI, and S. Ct.Prac.R. XVIII(7).
