O R D E R

On March 12, 2007, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this Court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Rahshann Blackwell's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved and applicant may reapply for the February 2009 exam. Applicant filed objections and the Board filed an answer. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Rahshann Blackwell for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved and he may apply to take the February 2009 bar examination, providing that (1) he has already undergone treatment with a licensed professional in psychology or psychiatry by that time, (2) he has been reevaluated by Dr. Hustak or another professional approved by the character and fitness board, at his own expense, and (3) he files with his application a copy of that professional's report.
