On September 24, 2004, this Court found appellant Gregory T. Howard to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(5)(B). On May 6, 2008, Howard filed a motion for leave to file an action against the Ohio Supreme Court in order to change the result in Mayer v. Bristow.
