This cause is pending before the Court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Fulton County. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered by the Court, sua sponte, that this cause is no longer held for the decision in *State v. Simpkins*, 117 Ohio St.3d 420, 2008-Ohio-1197, 884 N.E.2d 568, and briefing shall proceed.

It is further ordered that this cause shall be consolidated for oral argument with Supreme Court Case Nos. 2007-1415, *State v. Mosmeyer*, Hamilton App. No. C-060747, and 2007-1439, *State v. Barnes*, Portage App. No. 2006-P-0089, 2007-Ohio-3362. Appellants in these causes collectively will share thirty minutes for oral argument, as will appellees. Appellant in this cause may brief all of the Propositions of Law raised in these causes, but oral argument in this cause shall be restricted to appellant's double jeopardy claim.

It is further ordered that the Clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Fulton County, and the parties shall brief this case in accordance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio.
