The parties shall file any evidence they intend to present within 20 days of the date of this entry; relators shall file a brief within 30 days of the date of this entry; respondents shall file a brief within 20 days after the filing of relators' brief; and relators may file a reply brief within 7 days after filing of respondents' brief.
