## O R D E R

The Board on the Unauthorized Practice of Law filed its final report in this court on May 28, 2009, recommending that, pursuant to Rule VII of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio, the Supreme Court of Ohio issue an order finding that respondent, Gary Allan Heath, has engaged in the unauthorized practice of law; prohibiting respondent from engaging in the unauthorized practice of law in the future; providing for reimbursement of costs and expenses incurred by the board and relator; and, imposing a civil penalty in the amount of \$15,000. Respondent filed objections to the final report and this cause was considered by the court. On consideration thereof,

This court finds, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, that respondent's actions constitute the unauthorized practice of law, and,


It is ordered by the court, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, that respondent be enjoined from preparing legal documents on behalf of others for filing in court, from preparing legal documents and instruments upon which others' legal rights are secured or advanced, and from engaging in all other acts constituting the practice of law.

It is further ordered that respondent is fined \$1,000. The fine shall be paid to this court by certified check or money order on or before 30 days from the date of this order. If respondent fails to pay said fine on or before 30 days from the date of this order, the matter will be referred to the Attorney General for collection and this court may find respondent in contempt.

It is further ordered that respondent provide reimbursement of costs and expenses incurred by the board and relator in the amount of \$245.80, which costs shall be payable to this court by certified check or money order on or before 30 days from the date of this order. It is further ordered that if these costs are not paid in full on or before 30 days from the date of this order, interest at the rate of 10% per annum shall accrue on the balance of unpaid board costs, effective 30 days from the date of this order. It is further ordered that if costs are not paid in full on or before 30 days from the date of this order, this matter will be referred to the Attorney General for collection and respondent may be found in contempt.

It is further ordered, sua sponte, that all documents filed with this court in this case shall meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, including requirements as to form, number, and timeliness of filings. All case documents are subject to Rules 44 through 47 of the Rules of Superintendence of Ohio which govern access to court records.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. VII(19)(E); that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. VII(19)(F); and that respondent bear the costs of publication.
