
This cause is pending before the Court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Lucas County. On review of the order certifying a conflict,

It is determined that a conflict exists. The parties are to brief the issue stated at page 2 of the court of appeals' Decision and Judgment filed October 28, 2009, as follows:

“Whether R.C. 2901.13(F) operates to toll the six-year period of limitations provided for in R.C. 2901.13(A) so that it extends beyond six years from the date upon which a felony offense was committed where the corpus delicti of the offense is discovered within the period of limitations and more than one year prior to expiration of the limitations period.”

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Lucas County.
