This cause, here on appeal from the Court of Appeals for Warren County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the judgment of the court of appeals is reversed as to those portions of the judgment that rejected constitutional challenges to the Adam Walsh Act on separation-of-powers grounds, and this cause is remanded to the trial court for further proceeding, if any, necessitated by, *State v. Bodyke*, ___ Ohio St.3d, 2010-Ohio-2424, ___ N.E.2d ___.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to the Court of Common Pleas for Warren County to carry this judgment into execution and that a copy of this entry be certified to the Clerk of the Court of Appeals for Warren County for entry.
