

ORDER

On February 26, 2010, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Alexander Johnathin Zatik's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved and that he be permitted to apply for the July 2012 bar exam. The applicant did not file objections. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Alexander Johnathin Zatik for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved. It is further ordered that the applicant may apply for the July 2012 bar exam, provided that he submit a new application to register as a candidate for admission to the practice of law and is able to establish his character, fitness, and other qualifications.
