
This cause is pending before the Court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Meigs County. On review of the order certifying a conflict, it is determined that a conflict exists. The parties are to brief the issue stated at page 6 of the court of appeals' Entry filed January 13, 2011, as follows:

“If a defendant is notified about postrelease control at the sentencing hearing, but that notification is inadvertently omitted from the sentencing entry, can that omission be corrected with a nunc pro tunc entry?”

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Meigs County.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion for appointment of counsel, it is ordered by the Court that the motion is granted and that Timothy Young of the Ohio Public Defender's Office is appointed to represent appellant.
