

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the Court that a writ of mandamus is granted to compel respondent Secretary of State to treat Sections 1 and 2 of Sub.H.B. 319 as being subject to the constitutional right of referendum, to accept the submission of relators' referendum-petition summary, and to discharge the duties of his office as provided by Article II of the Ohio Constitution and R.C. 3519.01, consistent with the opinion rendered herein. Costs assessed to respondents.
