

Upon consideration of the jurisdictional memoranda filed in this case, the court declines jurisdiction to hear the case and dismisses the appeal as not involving any substantial constitutional question.

Upon consideration of appellant's motions to proceed on the original record filed in the trial court and the court of appeals, to reverse the court of appeal's judgment of August 18, 2011, to remand cause for further proceedings, and for determination that a conflict exists and/or finding that appellant has demonstrated a conflict, it is ordered by the court that appellant's motions are denied.

Upon consideration of the motion of appellee Toledo Hospital for sanctions pursuant to S.Ct. Prac. R. 14.5(A), and the motion of Mercy St. Anne's Hospital for sanctions for frivolous action, it is ordered by the court that the motions are denied.
