

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On December 22, 2010, the court suspended respondent for a period of two years with six months stayed on conditions. On May 19, 2011, relator filed a motion for an order to appear and show cause for failure to comply with the conditions of the December 22, 2010 order regarding respondent's clients and restitution to those clients. On May 20, 2011, respondent was ordered to show cause why he should not be found in contempt for failure to comply with the order to file an affidavit of compliance and pay board costs. On June 6, 2011, respondent was ordered to respond in writing to relator's motion within 10 days. Respondent did not respond. On June 29, 2011, the court ordered respondent to appear in person before the court on September 7, 2011. Respondent did appear. On September 22, 2011, the court granted relator's motion and ordered respondent, within 90 days of the order, to fully comply with the conditions of the December 22, 2010 order. To date, respondent has not fully complied.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that respondent show cause on or before 20 days from the date of this order, why respondent should not be found in contempt for failure to fully comply with this court's order of September 22, 2011, to wit: failure to file an affidavit of compliance on or before 90 days from the date of the September 22, 2011 order and failure to pay board costs in the amount of \$1,036.74, plus interest, on or before 90 days of the September 22, 2011 order.
