

IN MANDAMUS

ENTRY

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus and was considered in a manner prescribed by law.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the Court that a writ of mandamus is granted in part to compel the Cuyahoga County fiscal officer to provide relators copies of electronic images of all documents recorded in the Cuyahoga County Recorder's Office in July and August 2010 on compact discs at a cost of \$1 per disc, consistent with the opinion rendered herein. The writ of mandamus is denied insofar as it seeks to amend a policy that is no longer effective, consistent with the opinion rendered herein. Costs assessed to respondents.
