
ENTRY

This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Hamilton County. On review of the order certifying a conflict, it is determined that a conflict exists. The parties are to brief the issue stated at page 4 of the court of appeals' Judgment Entry filed December 23, 2011, as follows:

"May Senate Bill 10's classification, registration, and community-notification provisions be constitutionally applied to a sex offender who had committed his sex offense between the July 1, 2007, repeal of Megan's Law and the January 1, 2008, effective date of Senate Bill 10's classification, registration, and community-notification provisions?"

It is ordered by the court that the Clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Hamilton County.
