

**ORDER**

On August 3, 2011, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Jeffrey Vincent Gueli's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved and that he be permitted to reapply to take the July 2014 bar examination. The applicant filed objections, the relator filed an answer, and this cause was considered by the court.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, that the application of Jeffrey Vincent Gueli for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved and the applicant may submit a new application to register as a candidate for admission to the practice of law in Ohio no sooner than November 1, 2013, and may apply to take the July 2014 bar examination if he (1) continues treatment with Paul Hunkins and Dr. Wolf and follows their recommended treatment, (2) enters into a new three-year OLAP contract, and (3) fully complies with all its terms and conditions as verified by OLAP.
