Upon consideration of the jurisdictional memorandum filed in this case, the court accepts the appeal on Proposition of Law No. III.


It is ordered by the court that the clerk shall file the record in case No. 2011-2075 into this case.

It is further ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court case No. 2011-2075, *State v. Steele*, and shall be deemed a cross-appeal. The State of Ohio is hereby designated appellant/cross-appellee and Julian Steele is designated appellee/cross-appellant.

It is further ordered by the court that the briefing in case Nos. 2011-2178 and 2011-2075 shall be consolidated. The parties shall file two originals of each of the briefs permitted under S.Ct. Prac. R. 6.5 and include both case numbers on the cover page of the briefs. The parties shall otherwise comply with the requirements of S.Ct. Prac. R. 6.5. The briefs filed pursuant to this entry shall supersede the briefs previously filed in 2011-2075.

Appellant/cross-appellee shall file its brief within 40 days of the date of this entry and briefing shall otherwise proceed as provided in S.Ct. Prac. 6.5.
