

ENTRY

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of prohibition involving adoption and was considered in a manner prescribed by law.

Upon consideration and pursuant to S.Ct. Prac. R. 10.5, it is ordered by the court that a writ of prohibition is granted to prevent Judge Capper from exercising further jurisdiction and to compel Judge Capper to find void the orders that have been entered in that case, including his order of genetic testing, and to dismiss the case.
