

ORDER

On March 13, 2012, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Robin Leigh Burch's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved but that she be permitted to apply for the February 2013 bar examination. The applicant filed objections, and this matter was considered by the court.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Robin Leigh Burch for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved. It is further ordered that the applicant may apply to take the February 2013 bar exam by timely submitting a new application to take the bar examination in accordance with Gov.Bar R. I(3) and submitting an updated report from the Ohio Lawyers Assistance Program.
