
JUDGMENT ENTRY

APPEAL FROM THE
COURT OF APPEALS

This cause, here on appeal from the Court of Appeals for Lake County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the judgment of the court of appeals is reversed, the appellant's sentence on the firearm specification is vacated, and this cause is remanded to the trial court for resentencing consistent with the opinion rendered herein.
