

ORDER

On March 13, 2012, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Ebonie Michelle Martin's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved and that she be permitted to apply to take the July 2014 bar examination on conditions. The applicant did not file objections.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Ebonie Michelle Martin for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved and that she may apply to take the July 2014 bar examination by filing a new application to register as a candidate for admission to the practice of law and an application to take the bar examination. Upon reapplication, she shall undergo a complete character and fitness investigation, including an investigation and report by the National Conference of Bar Examiners and a review and interview by the appropriate admissions committee.
