

This cause is pending before the court as a death penalty appeal from the Court of Common Pleas for Cuyahoga County.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that the parties shall file supplemental briefs addressing Proposition of Law No. XV, as now applicable in light of *Williams v. Illinois*, 132 S.Ct. 2221 (2012), *Bullcoming v. New Mexico*, 131 S.Ct. 2705 (2011), and *Melendez-Diaz v. Massachusetts*, 129 S.Ct. 2527 (2009).

Supplemental briefing shall proceed as follows: appellant shall file a supplemental brief within twenty days of the date of this entry and appellee shall file a brief within twenty days of the date of the filing of appellant's brief. Appellant may file a reply brief within ten days of the date of the filing of appellee's brief. The clerk's office shall refuse to file any requests for extension of time.
