
This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County.

Upon consideration of the motion to withdraw of Victoria Ullmann as counsel for ProgressOhio.Org in order to be made a party/appellant in this action, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted in part. The withdrawal of counsel is granted, and the request to be made a party is denied.

Upon consideration of Victoria Ullmann's motion to require counsel for the 1851 Center to file proof of compliance with rules of conduct for the bar regarding improper contact with a represented party of interest or withdraw from case, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

Upon consideration of appellant ProgressOhio.org, Inc's motion to strike Victoria E. Ullmann's motion to withdraw, and motion to dismiss and strike Victoria E.
