

ORDER

On September 30, 2011, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E). On April 10, 2012, this court remanded this matter to the board for further consideration. On March 15, 2013, the board filed its final report on remand, recommending that Christopher Stanley Christman Webber's application for admission without examination not be approved and that his registration for corporate status in Ohio be terminated. The applicant did not file objections.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Christopher Stanley Christman Webber for admission without examination to the Ohio bar is disapproved and his registration for corporate status is hereby terminated. It is further ordered that if applicant should desire to practice law in the state of Ohio in the future, he may apply to take the bar examination and submit to a full character and fitness investigation by the appropriate bar-association admissions committee. It is further ordered that until applicant is duly admitted to the Ohio bar, he shall not seek admission pro hac vice, register for corporate status, or otherwise practice law in this state.
