
JUDGMENT ENTRY

APPEAL FROM THE
COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

This cause, here on appeal from the Court of Appeals for Summit County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, Wesson's conviction for aggravated murder in Count Three, the specification related to that count, and the specification to Count Two alleging that he committed the murder while under detention are reversed. The remaining convictions, the imposition of capital punishment on Count Two, and the imposition of consecutive terms of imprisonment on the noncapital offense convictions are affirmed.

It is further ordered that mandates be sent to and filed with the clerks of the Court of Appeals for Summit County and the Court of Common Pleas for Summit County.
