

ORDER

On March 13, 2013, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Daniel Robert Goodstein's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved and that he be permitted to reapply for the February 2015 bar examination upon conditions. The applicant did not file objections.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Daniel Robert Goodstein for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved. It is further ordered that, upon satisfaction of his full obligation to the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services in the amount of \$6,705.04 plus interest accruing thereon, applicant may reapply for admission by filing a new application to register as a candidate and undergoing a new character and fitness evaluation, and may apply to take the July 2015 bar examination.
