
This cause is pending before the court as an appeal and cross-appeal from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

Upon consideration of appellant/cross-appellees' motion to seal confidential portion of the appendix and confidential portion of the supplement to merit brief, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot. The documents are currently being maintained under seal pursuant to Sup.R. 44(C)(1) and Sup.Ct.Prac.R. 3.02(B), and the court will decide whether the commission properly protected the documents as trade secrets after briefing and oral argument.

Upon consideration of appellee/cross-appellant The Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel's motion for hearing, it is ordered by the court that the motion for hearing is denied.

It is further ordered by the court that briefing shall resume. The second merit briefs of the cross-appellants, The Office of Ohio Consumers' Counsel and Environmental Law & Policy Center, are due 30 days from the date of the entry, and the parties shall otherwise proceed according to S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.05.
