

ORDER

On April 2, 2014, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Matthew Steven Grimsley's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved but that he be permitted to apply for the July 2014 bar examination. The applicant did not file objections.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Matthew Steven Grimsley for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved. It is further ordered that the applicant may apply to take the bar exam in February 2015, or a later bar exam, provided that he submits a new application to register as a candidate for admission to the practice of law and is able to establish that he has the requisite character, fitness, and other qualifications.
