

ORDER

On March 18, 2014, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Thomas Donald Baudendistel's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved, but that he be permitted to reapply for the February 2015 bar examination. The applicant did not file objections.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Thomas Donald Baudendistel for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved. It is further ordered that he may apply to take the July 2015 bar examination or a later bar exam, provided that he submits a new application to register as a candidate for admission to the practice of law in accordance with Gov.Bar R. I(3) and is able to establish that he has the requisite character, fitness, and other qualifications.
