THE COURT OF APPEALS


This cause, here on a certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Ashland County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the certified question is answered as follows:

The term “penal or correctional institution of a party state,” as used in R.C. 2963.30, includes a county jail as well as a state prison or correctional facility.

Accordingly, the judgment of the court of appeals is affirmed, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the clerk of the Court of Appeals for Ashland County.
