
APPEAL FROM THE
COURT OF APPEALS

This cause, here on appeal from the Court of Appeals for Butler County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the judgment of the court of appeals is affirmed with regard to the writ of mandamus, and the portion of the court of appeals' decision addressing the writ of prohibition is vacated, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered by the court that the court of appeals' decision to grant statutory damages is affirmed, the court of appeals' denial of attorney fees is reversed, and this matter is remanded to the court of appeals so that it may hear evidence and make an appropriate award of attorney fees.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the clerk of the Court of Appeals for Butler County.
