
JUDGMENT ENTRY

APPEAL FROM THE
COURT OF APPEALS

This cause, here on appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the judgment of the court of appeals is affirmed. The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for Fairfield County's Tussing Wastewater Plant is vacated with respect to the unpromulgated phosphorus standard. This cause is remanded to the Ohio EPA for proceedings consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that mandates be sent to and filed with the clerks of the Court of Appeals for Franklin County and the Court of Common Pleas for Franklin County.
