

This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of appellee/cross-appellant Teddy Wheeler's motions for argument to the Supreme Court and to enlarge time for oral argument, it is ordered by the court that the motion for argument to the Supreme Court is granted, and the motion to enlarge time for oral argument is granted in part. Accordingly, oral argument in this case shall proceed as follows: appellant/cross-appellee, Martin Marietta Energy Systems, Inc., shall argue first and is permitted ten minutes of oral argument time and may reserve time for rebuttal; appellee/cross-appellee, Tax Commissioner of Ohio, shall argue second and is permitted ten minutes of oral argument time; and appellee/cross-appellant, Teddy Wheeler, Pike County Auditor, shall argue third and is permitted twenty minutes of oral argument time.
