
This cause came on for further consideration upon appellee's motion to set an execution date.

TO THE WARDEN OF THE SOUTHERN OHIO CORRECTIONAL FACILITY:

The Supreme Court of Ohio, having affirmed the judgment of the Court of Appeals for Lucas County and the sentence imposed by the Lucas County Court of Common Pleas, in the case of The State of Ohio vs. Archie J. Dixon, and Archie J. Dixon, having been indicted and convicted of the crime of aggravated murder with specification(s) in the Court of Common Pleas, you are hereby commanded to proceed on Wednesday, the 20th day of March, 2019 (the day fixed by the Supreme Court of Ohio), to carry into execution the sentence of death pronounced on Archie J.
