
This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Wood County. On review of the order certifying a conflict, it is determined that a conflict exists. The parties are to brief the issue stated at page 26 of the court of appeals' Judgment Entry filed February 6, 2015, as follows:

“Must the state, in prosecuting cocaine offenses involving mixed substances under R.C. 2925.11(C)(4)(a) through (f), prove that the weight of the cocaine meets the statutory threshold, excluding the weight of any filler materials used in the mixture?”

It is ordered by the court that the clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Wood County.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court Case No. 2015-385, *State of Ohio v. Rafael Gonzales*, and that the briefing in Case Nos. 2015-0384 and 2015-385 shall be consolidated. The parties shall file two originals of each of the briefs permitted under S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02-16.04 and include both case numbers on the cover page of the briefs. The parties shall otherwise comply with the requirements of S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.01-16.04.
