
This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Summit County. On review of the order certifying a conflict, it is determined that a conflict exists. The parties are to brief the issue stated at page 2 of the court of appeals' Judgment Entry filed May 14, 2015, as follows:

“When appealing an unemployment compensation decision to the trial court, are the requirements contained in R.C. 4141.282(D), which explains how to name the parties, mandatory requirements necessary to perfect the appeal and vest the trial court with jurisdiction?”

It is ordered by the court that the clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Summit County.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court Case No. 2015-0770, *Marcus Pryor, II v. Director, Ohio Department of Job and Family Services*, and that the briefing in Case Nos. 2015-0767 and 2015-0770 shall be consolidated. The parties shall file two originals of each of the briefs permitted under S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02-16.04 and include both case numbers on the cover page of the briefs. The parties shall otherwise comply with the requirements of S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.01-16.04.
