ENTRY


This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus involving an expedited election case and was considered in a manner prescribed by law.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that the writ of mandamus is granted with respect to respondents Mahoning County Board of Elections, David Betras, Mark Munroe, Robert Wasko, and Tracey Winbush, and the writ of mandamus is denied with respect to respondent Ohio Secretary of State Jon Husted, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that relator's motions to correct a clerical error and for leave to file an amended complaint are granted.

It is further ordered by the court that due to the short time remaining to finalize ballots, no additional motions shall be filed in this case, and the clerk of court shall refuse to file any additional motions.
