
JUDGMENT ENTRY

CERTIFIED CONFLICT FROM
THE COURT OF APPEALS

This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Summit County and was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the judgment of the court of appeals is affirmed in part, reversed in part, and Edward South's mandatory three-year prison sentence associated with his repeat-offender-specification conviction is reinstated. This cause is remanded to the trial court for resentencing on the underlying operating-a-vehicle-while-under-the-influence conviction in accordance with R.C. 2929.14(A)(3)(b), consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the clerk of the Court of Appeals for Summit County.
