
This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County. On review of the order certifying a conflict, it is determined that a conflict exists. The parties are to brief the issue stated at page 2 of the court of appeals' journal entry filed July 2, 2015, as follows:

“Whether an order denying a motion to quash a grand jury subpoena and ordering a party to testify and/or produce documents is an order granting or denying a provisional remedy within the meaning of R.C. 2505.02(A)(3)?”

It is ordered by the court that the clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

It is further ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court Case No. 2015-1181, *In re: Grand Jury Proceeding of John Doe*, and that the briefing in Case Nos. 2015-1182 and 2015-1181 shall be consolidated. The parties shall file two originals of each of the briefs permitted under S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02-16.04 and include both case numbers on the cover page of the briefs. The parties shall otherwise comply with the requirements of S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.01-16.04.
