
ENTRY

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus, procedendo and prohibition.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that a peremptory writ of mandamus is granted compelling the issuance of a final, appealable order in relator's criminal case, *State v. McIntyre*, Summit C.P. No. CR-91-01-0135, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

Further, the court denies respondents' motion to dismiss and relator's request for oral argument.

It is further ordered by the court that the writ of prohibition is premature and is dismissed.
