

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that an alternative writ is granted and the following briefing schedule is set for presentation of evidence and filing of briefs pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 12.05:

The parties shall file any evidence they intend to present within 20 days of the date of this entry; relators shall file a brief within 10 days of the filing of the evidence; respondent shall file a brief within 20 days after the filing of relators' brief; and relators may file a reply brief within 7 days after the filing of respondent's brief.

It is further ordered that respondent's motion for judgment on the pleadings is denied and the motion to stay discovery of respondent is granted.
