ENTRY


This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion for oral argument of Crutchfield, Inc. and Tax Commissioner of Ohio, Joseph W. Testa, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted.

It is further ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court Case Nos. 2015-0483, *Newegg, Inc., (et al.) v. Joseph W. Testa, Tax Commissioner of Ohio, (et al.)*, and 2015-0794, *Mason Companies, Inc. (et al.) v. Joseph W. Testa, Tax Commissioner of Ohio, (et al.)* for oral argument only. One hour total shall be allotted for the combined cases and thirty minutes shall be allotted to appellants/cross-appellees and thirty minutes shall be allotted to appellee/cross-appellant, Tax Commissioner of Ohio.

No later than ten days before oral argument, counsel for appellants/cross-appellees shall file a notice of how they intend to divide the thirty minutes of oral argument time allotted to appellants/cross-appellees.
