
ENTRY

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for writs of mandamus and prohibition involving an expedited election case and was considered in a manner prescribed by law.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that a writ of mandamus is granted to compel the Greene County Board of Elections to remove the Sugar creek Township levy from the March 15, 2016 ballot. All other requests for writs of mandamus and prohibition are denied, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that due to the short time remaining to finalize ballots, no additional motions shall be filed in this case, and the clerk of court shall refuse to file any additional motions.
