
This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County. On review of the order certifying a conflict, it is determined that a conflict exists. The parties are to brief the issue stated as follows:

“In the course of a traffic stop, does the Fifth Amendment to the United States Constitution and Section 10, Article I of the Ohio Constitution require a law enforcement officer to provide *Miranda* warnings to a suspect who is removed from his vehicle and placed in the front seat of a police vehicle for questioning?”

It is ordered by the court that the clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court Case No. 2016-0282, *City of Cleveland v. Benjamin S. Oles*, and that the briefing in Case Nos. 2016-0172 and 2016-0282 shall be consolidated. The parties shall file two originals of each of the briefs permitted under S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02-16.04 and include both case numbers on the cover page of the briefs. The parties shall otherwise comply with the requirements of S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.01-16.04.
