

ORDER

On April 3, 2015, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that Matthew Ashley Swendiman's application for admission to the Ohio bar without examination be disapproved and that he be permitted to reapply upon conditions. The applicant did not file objections.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of Matthew Ashley Swendiman for admission to the Ohio bar without examination is disapproved. It is further ordered that Swendiman may reapply for admission without examination, and if he does, he will be subject to a full character and fitness examination. It is further ordered that Swendiman shall immediately cease and desist all activities constituting the practice of law in Ohio unless and until he is duly licensed to practice in this state.
