

In re: Application of John David Tynes

ORDER

On April 3, 2015, the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness filed its final report in this court pursuant to Gov.Bar R. I(12)(E), recommending that John David Tynes's application to take the Ohio bar examination be disapproved and that he not be permitted to reapply for admission to the practice of law in Ohio. The applicant filed objections to said final report, relator filed an answer, oral argument was held, and this cause was considered by the court.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that, consistent with the opinion rendered herein, the application of John David Tynes for admission to the practice of law in Ohio is disapproved. It is further ordered that the applicant may reapply for admission to the practice of law in Ohio by filing an application to take the July 2018 or a later bar examination and establishing that he possesses the requisite character, fitness, and moral qualifications for admission to the practice of law in Ohio.
