
JUDGMENT ENTRY

COURT OF APPEALS

This cause, here on appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the judgment of the court of appeals is reversed and this cause is remanded to the court of appeals for a determination of Demetrius Jones's appeal utilizing the two-part, burden-shifting test outlined in *State v. Whiting*, 84 Ohio St.3d 215, 217, 702 N.E.2d 1199 (1998) and analyzing Jones's claim of actual prejudice, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that mandate be sent to and filed with the clerks of the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County and the Court of Common Pleas for Cuyahoga County.
