
APPEAL FROM THE

This cause, here on appeal from the Court of Appeals for Meigs County, was considered in the manner prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, the judgment of the court of appeals is reversed, and a writ of mandamus is granted compelling the Meigs County Board of Commissioners to adopt a resolution placing the proposed charter on the November 8, 2016 general-election ballot, consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that appellants' motion for leave to file affidavit of appellant's counsel in opposition to Meigs County Commissioners' motion to strike instanter is denied as moot.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the clerk of the Court of Appeals for Meigs County.
